

Absence through illness. We understand and appreciate that children can become ill and that it is not always easy to decide as to whether to send them into school or not. To help you with this decision we have devised a useful reference guide:

RED - STAY AT HOME Sickness & Diarrhoea - 48 hours must have elapsed before a child can return to school from the last episode. Covid symptoms

AMBER - SEEK ADVICE Headache, Feeling Sick, Tummy Ache. Children often feel unwell if they are anxious, so if in doubt contact the school for advice

GREEN - COME TO SCHOOL Mild cough, Cold, Sore Throat, Feeling Tired. We will always contact you if your child is ill during the school day

If your child is too ill to attend school, please let us know via the absence line. If we do not hear from you, we will ring you to find out why your child is not in school.
